

Return to Compliance (RTC) Qualifiers

Documented	Owner/operator demonstrated that it is in full compliance by submitting the appropriate documentation to the approved Health District or Ohio EPA. This includes the submittal of paperwork or reports, albeit late.
Observed	Verified by on-site inspection that this violation was corrected or abated and the operator/owner is now in full compliance with that specific requirement.
Cannot Be Resolved – <i>No Enforcement</i>	Used when a violation cannot be resolved, but enforcement will not occur. For example, an NOV for late submittal of a report.
Enforcement – <i>On Compliance Schedule</i>	Used when an enforcement case has been settled and the entity will not be in full actual compliance until completing the requirements of the DFFOs.
Enforcement – <i>Cannot Be Resolved</i>	Used when an enforcement case has been settled, but the violation cannot be resolved. For example, hazardous waste was taken at a landfill, and the entity pays a penalty, but leaves the waste in the landfill.
